## Veterans can get ID cards at Muncie VA clinic in July

FORT WAYNE, Ind. – VA Northern Indiana Health Care System will be providing Veteran Identification Cards to eligible individuals in July, every Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at the Muncie VA Clinic, 2600 W. White River Blvd., Muncie, Ind. 47303.

A VA Veteran ID Card can be used in lieu of a DD Form-214 to obtain discount goods and services offered to Veterans. It is different from the VA Veterans Health Identification Card which is used at VA facilities to securely check-in for healthcare appointments.

To receive a VA Veteran ID Card, a person must meet these requirements:

- Served on active duty, in the Reserves, or in the National Guard (including the Coast Guard)
- Received an honorable or general discharge (under honorable conditions)
- Provide a government-issued photo ID, i.e. driver's license and a copy of a DD Form 214 to prove the type of discharge.

No appointment is necessary to receive a card. There will also be VA staff available to enroll eligible Veterans and answer questions about VA health care. For questions or additional information, contact the Veterans Outreach and Experience Program 800-360-8387, ext. 71998.
